NEWS FROM YOUR PARISH COUNCILMAN

<u>Tammany Utilities East Issues:</u> The chloramines conversion of the Tammany Utilities East plant has been completed and LDH (Louisiana Department of Health) has officially changed the designation of the Cross Gates Water System from free chlorine to chloramines. Also, T U East was cited with a NOV (Notice of Violation) on January 10th 2018 over water related issues and all items on the NOV have been addressed, but not all items on this list have been completed. Some of these items are the flow meters. Flow meters, pipes and fittings have been received and a contractor has complete the installation on most wells to date. T U East has placed all of their sampling data on their website. TU east has installed new metering pumps and calibration tubes at the 3 well locations to improve the sampling process to date; there is still work to be done as you know. If you see something say something to Tammany Utilities East (985) 643-1376. (Greg Gorden is their Director)

T U East submitted budget amendments for TU East projects – they are for the following; sewer lift stations: Herwig Bluff, Cross Gates Apts., Goldenwood, Big School, Meadow Lake, Willow Wood, Phase 5, St. Luke's, Essex, Cross Gates Blvd/Dover, Cross Gates Boulevard/ Camden, Goldenwood/Silverwood. These rebuilds should be completed by December of this year. Each of these 12 lift stations will also get a new auto dialer and the staff is also placing new audible alarms on the sewer lift stations. If you here one sounding please call Tammany Utilities East at (<u>985) 643-1376</u> and let them know where and when the alarm sounded. The five inches of rain on Saturday, April 14th caused a lot of water to flood the sewer system. We experienced overflows at the Essex and Herwig Bluff lift stations, which will be reported to LDEQ in accordance with our discharge permit.

Lower W-15 Drainage Project: The Lower W-15 drainage project that includes a 52 acre tract with a 42 acre retention pond and the N. Pearl Street drainage projects will improve the drainage in the new Cross Gates and Lake Village area. The overall project will store rainfall from the north and then gradually release it and will benefit many surrounding sub divisions. The pond is expected to be completed by March or April 2019 and then there will be improvements to the W-15 canal south and east of Cross Gates.

Capital Projects: The 2017 supplemental capital projects – Bristol Place and Camden Street construction is expected to start in mid-July and the 2018 capital projects – Hampton Lane and Woodruff Drive phase 2 are expected to start by mid-September or early October. Drainage concerns; I received calls or emails from residents regarding street flooding especially this past January and Saturday April 14th, 2018. Our area was overwhelmed by the amount of rain in a short period of time. One item brought to my attention was street drains clogged by leaves and pine needles. This slows down the drainage so if you have a catch basin in front of your home and the weather forecast is for a heavy rain, please remove the material from the catch basin grates as it helps the rate of flow of the streets tremendously. Please be aware of your surroundings before a heavy rain and pitch in and help your neighbors who may not be able to clear these catch basins in front of their homes.
